SCHOLARSHIPS CHANGE LIVES

Author, *Hope Personified: Frances Maschal Landers*

A tall, stately woman and a much taller black man stood beside his battered Land Rover on a rutted trail that ended part way to the top of a treeless mountain. The two looked toward a simple mission church made of stone.

"I want you to build a school next to each of my seven mission churches," said the Haitian Episcopal priest.



This story from 1989 is near folklore for the Americans who came alongside Frances to start ending illiteracy in Haiti's mountain villages. Pere Albert had easily convinced Frances, a former schoolteacher, that the only hope for Haiti was to educate its boys and girls.

Frances and Pere Albert knew they owed their supporters and the Lord a high degree of accountability as they did His work, so they settled on a budget. Fifty-five dollars for each student, collectively, funded the teachers' and principals' salaries and a few school supplies.

That was thirty years ago. Today, Haitian teachers justifiably earn a higher salary, so a scholarship is seventy-five dollars. Think of what seventy-five dollars provides: an entire school year of quality, Christians-based education taught by loving teachers and overseen by local priests. And true to one of Frances' founding tenets, one hundred percent of your donations go straight to work in Haiti.

Across thirty years, thousands of children have graduated from these mountain schools. Yet Haiti Education Foundation never takes for granted the generosity of its supporters.

Each scholarship you provide changes the life of a Haitian boy or girl.

Added together, the scholarships are doing far more than funding teachers and principals. They are developing the next generation of Haitian leaders who will do amazing things for the country they love.

YOUR FINANCIAL SUPPORT IS VITAL TO OUR MISSION OUTREACH

We must meet a budget of \$433,800.00 each year in order to pay our staff and operate our schools. As always, 100% of all donations are used as designated by the donor. REBUILDING St. Matthias Preschool & Elementary



In the January of 2018, the doors to the newly built St. Matthias High School were opened. This brought about much excitement in the community which was heavily affected by the earthquake. As of September, Principal Louis Jean Manesse reports that the enrollment is at 350 students...an increase of 100 students from this time last year. We are excited to announce that we have plans to rebuild the preschool and elementary school within the next year. This school will sit on the site of the original high school which was destroyed in January of 2010. The total cost for the sixteen room concrete building is expected to be \$160,000.00. We are excited that we have already raised \$65,000.00. A donor has agreed to work with us on matching donations for the remaining costs of the construction. Please prayerfully consider a gift to this project. Our number one concern is always funding scholarships and we do not want to direct funds away from that ongoing effort. 
